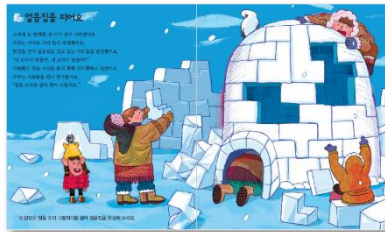
## <The Lost expedition: Journey to a mysterious cave>
